After high school, she attended Joliet Jr. College receiving an Associate of Arts and Science in Fashion Merchandising. Cheryl continued her education and graduated from North Texas State University with a Bachelor degree.

After graduation she was employed in the retail businesses of Dillard's, Foleys and Macy's Department Stores before accepting her present and last position with Sound Physicians. Her positions have taken her from Denton to Dallas to McAllen to San Antonio and back to Dallas.

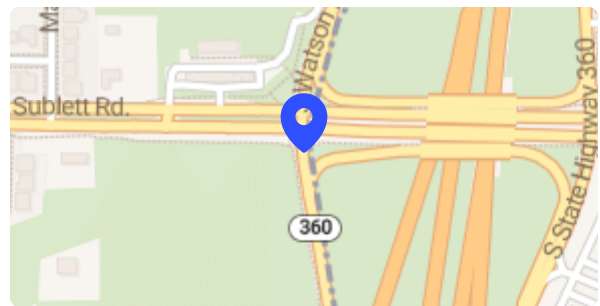
