Marvis Yvonne Brown was the youngest child of twelve born to Lula Armstrong Brown and Frank C. Brown on December 25, 1936, in Laurel, Mississippi. She graduated from Oak Park High School in 1954. She then attended Vallejo Jr. College in Vallejo, California. She later transferred to Grady Memorial School of Nursing at Spelman College in Atlanta, Georgia. Upon receiving her Bachelor of Science in Nursing, she returned to her home state and accepted the position of Head Nurse of Pediatrics at Mississippi State Hospital in Jackson, Mississippi. After three years, she accepted a position as Assistant Director of Student Health. Her tenure there would lead to her employment as the Director of the Foster Johnson Health Center on the campus of Grambling State University in Grambling, Louisiana, where she retired after more than thirty years of dedicated service.

On March 21, 1969, she married Roscoe St. Clair Brown. God blessed this union with two children Marcia and Michael Brown. She was a very meticulous person and always wanted everything to be in its assigned place, but sometimes she had to add her own personal, final touch. She was a very caring and giving person.

She accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior at a very young age. She was an active member of Lewis Temple CME Church for over forty-five years where she served in many of the ministries prior to relocating to Arlington, Texas. She was also a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated.

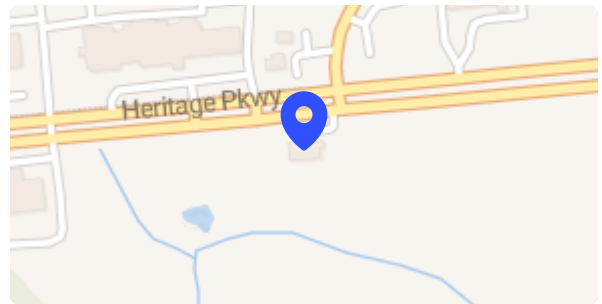

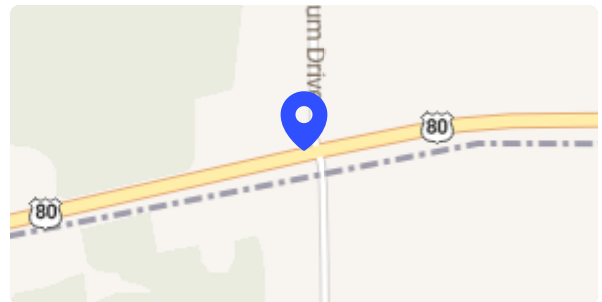
