Sherrie Boyd entered into her heavenly rest, transitioning peacefully at home on March 6, 2022. To be clear Sherrie was a survivor acting with a sense of urgency, life, and love. She knew she had work to do and she got it done lighting the path to God by showing forth His Grace.

Sherrie Mildred Boyd was born on May 14, 1960 in Flint Michigan. She is the daughter of the late Rev. John T. Boyd and Phyllis (Shepard) Boyd.

Affectionately known as “ReeRee”, Sherrie shared her childhood with her lovable older sister Pam, and attentive younger sister, Laurie.

Sherrie accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized by Rev. Robert R. Gordon at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church in Flint, Michigan. She enjoyed singing in the choir. Later she joined Galilee Missionary Baptist church under the leadership of her father, Rev. John T. Boyd, where she took on the role as the church’s secretary.

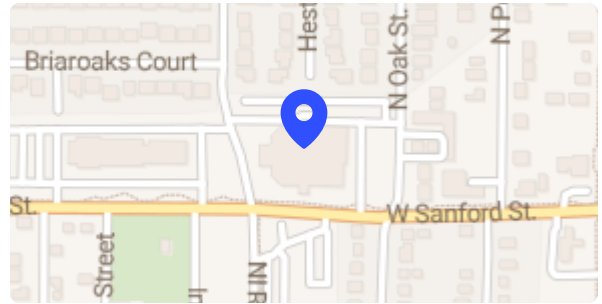

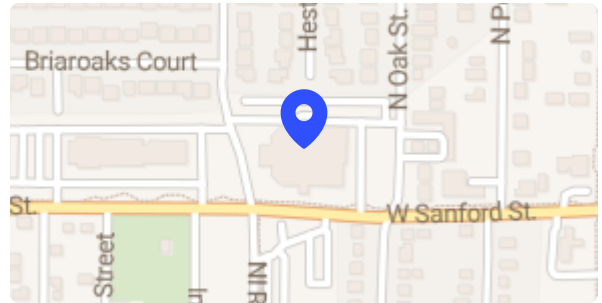
