He accepted Christ at an early age and AD was educated in the DeSoto Parish School District of Ward-6 before he moved away to Dallas, Texas.

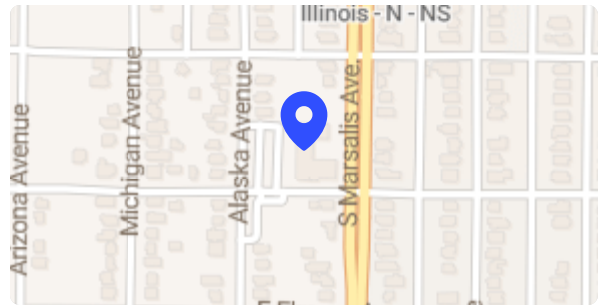
